



I-Suite Patch 2007-3 Release Notes

Release: I-Suite 7.01.03

This is a critical update to prevent resources from inadvertently being reassigned to another incident when working with “Manage All As One” selected.

Description: The primary purpose of this patch is to prevent resources from inadvertently being reassigned to another incident when working with “Manage All As One” selected. This can happen when there are multiple incidents in the database, “Manage All As One” is selected and a resource is edited from a module other than the Resources module. This patch includes additional items listed below.

Note: If resources have already inadvertently been reassigned, this patch will not move them back to the correct incident.

Things to know prior to installing I-Suite Patch 2007-3

- Includes all previous patches released since I-Suite version 7.01.01.
- Recommend that this patch be installed on all computers running I-Suite 7.01.01 with or without previous patches.
- This patch will update a server or client installation of I-Suite.
- System Administrative privileges are NOT required to properly install this patch.
- This patch can be installed mid-incident.
- Close the I-Suite application and all related windows on the local computer before installing this patch.
- The installation of I-Suite Patch 2007-3 will replace the OF286.rpt and the ISuite.exe files.

Summary Release Information

The following table contains a summary of the changes included in this patch:

Module	Process	Description
General	Edit Resource	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Resources are no longer inadvertently being reassigned to another incident when editing from a module other than the Resources module.
Data Admin	Add or Edit Incident	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Incident number must be unique within the current database.Will not allow saving without an incident number.
Data Admin	Add or Edit Account Code	<ul style="list-style-type: none">A warning message now displays when an Account Code that is assigned to another incident in the current database is added.
Time	Post Crew / Personnel Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Tabbing past the Save button now returns the curser to the Activity Date block.
Time	General	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The application no longer locks when the Time module is open and the application is minimized and then restored.
