



I-Suite Patch 11-1 Release Notes

Date: November 28, 2011

Version: I-Suite 11.01.02

Description: The primary focus of this patch is to address two major issues affecting Cost, correct several items found during the Supply Pilot and several minor defects impacting the field. All changes included in this patch are identified in the Summary Release Information section of this document.

Things to know prior to installing I-Suite Patch 11-1, Version 11.01.02

- There are three different patches available depending on your configuration and operating system. See chart below:

I-Suite Patch 11-1 Client 32	Windows XP 32 Bit Operating System	For use on Windows XP Client installs . Client version is currently not supported on Windows 7. To find your operating system, click the link below and follow instructions. http://support.microsoft.com/kb/827218

Note: *Has not been tested on Windows Vista or Windows XP 64 Bit operating systems.*

- Recommend that this patch be installed on all computers running I-Suite 11.01.00.
- This patch can be applied to a server or client installation of I-Suite.
- System Administrative privileges are required to properly install this patch.
- This patch can be installed mid-incident.
- For both Server and Client computers, close the I-Suite application and all related windows on the local computer before installing this patch.
- It is recommended that a back-up of the I-Suite database be made prior to any application updates.

- The installation of I-Suite Patch 11-1 will replace the following files: ISuite.exe, Waybill.rpt, SupplyIssueReceipt.rpt, IsuiteBlank.mdf.gpg and 2011_Training.mdf.gpg.
- Opening the I-Suite application on the server computer, attaching a database, and creating a new database will update the database to version 11.01.06.
