



I-Suite 7.01.01 Summary Release Notes

Date: April 23, 2007

Release: I-Suite 7.01.01

Description: The primary focus of this release is to complete several outstanding items and to fix recently identified issues in the application.

The Full install and the Update can both be installed mid-incident. Run a backup of your database prior to updating I-Suite.

Important things to know prior to installing version 7.01.01 (Full)

- System Administrative privileges are required to properly install the full I-Suite Server and Client installations. You must reboot after the installation is finished and re-login with System Administrative privileges for the install to complete.
- The installation of I-Suite Version 7.01.01 will remove I-Suite 2005 versions.
- 2005 and earlier versions of I-Suite are not compatible with this version. There is no conversion process for 2005 to 2007.
- System Administrative privileges are not required to run the application.
 - o To set up the I-Suite server, the initial server login user name is **admin**, and the default password is **forests**.
 - o This login will launch a new setup password screen.
 - o The initial password to copy the ISuiteBlank and to attach the practice database is **forests**.
- The new database version is 7.01.00.

Important things to know prior to installing version 7.01.01 (Update)

- Only install this update on a computer with I-Suite version 6.01.00 or newer already installed.
- System Administrative privileges are required to properly install the update. You do need to reboot after installation.
- To use the Update file, I-Suite must be installed in the default path of C:\Program Files\Isuite. If I-Suite was installed to any other path, the user must uninstall and reinstall using the full installer.
- The new database version is 7.01.01. Attached databases will be automatically updated to the current database version.

It was also added to the menu that displays when right clicking a form. Time	OF-286	<p>Personnel and Crew Post tabs are now disabled.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If no previous payments were made to the resource, None now prints under the Partial Payments Made label on the OF-286. • Deductions/Adjustments prior to the date of the first posted time are now included on the OF-286. • If there are Missing Days of Posted Time when printing or previewing an OF-286, a warning message now displays. • The following statement now prints at the top of all OF-286 invoices: "This invoice has not received a final audit and is subject to change prior to payment." • A new Invoice Number is generated when there are postings or adjustments with different Account Codes, Incident Names or Numbers. • When generating an OF-286, the End Date for the invoice now looks for Deductions after the last posting. • The Contractor Address is no longer truncated on the OF-286.

(<i>This also applies to crews with AD's</i>).

A checkmark in this checkbox prevents the application from automatically changing the Accrual Code for the resource. • If the Agency Code = CCC or OES and the Incident State is CA, the Accrual Code is correctly set to STL. • Only Air Resources with an agency of AMD will accrue. 						
Cost	Create Cost	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ability to create or update cost records for Resources Selected in the Grid was added to the Cost module. • The Cost module now uses the Estimated Date of Arrival from Demob to stop generating estimated costs. If an Estimated Date of Arrival is not defined, the application uses the Actual Release Date or the Incident End Date. The Estimated Date of Arrival will also display on the Cost grid view. • New processes were added to the Create Cost Processes drop-down list. This gives the Cost module

Cost	Divisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When the Division checkbox is selected, I-Suite now prompts the user to identify whether to apply the division to all subordinate resources for that date.
Cost	Rates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aircraft was removed from Rates (<i>All aircraft rates are user defined.</i>)
Cost	Reports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Division Report is now display correctly when the Selective Divisions option is selected. The Accrual Summary now groups by Incident and Account Code, similar to the Accrual Detail Report. In the Cost Share Apportionment Summary, the percents listed in the Report Total for the Incident row are now correct.
